

CLEANING YOUR TAURUS LEATHER TOOL BELT

Just like your own skin, the leather on your Taurus tool belt will benefit from being cleaned and moisturised.

STEP ONE

Empty your tool belt completely. Shake off all the loose materials and brush off dirt and debris.



STEP TWO



Clean with <u>Saddle Soap</u>. With a damp rag or small brush, rub the surface of the saddle soap in a circular motion to create a light lather. Apply to the surface of the leather. Repeat until the entire belt has been cleaned, then allow to air dry. Padding the pockets with newsprint will help draw moisture out of the leather and dry in an ideal shape.

STEP THREE*

For the black or the brown leather toolbelts in the Taurus Professional Series, you can apply <u>Aussie Leather Conditioner</u> with a soft rag, chamois or terrycloth. This nourishes, preserves, and protects the leather whilst refreshing colour to help cover scuffs and scratches. Use circular motions without pushing down too hard. Note that almost all conditioners can darken the leather.



STEP FOUR

Rest the tool belt overnight and rub with a dry rag to absorb any excess oils or moisture.

*Only recommended for the black and brown Taurus Professional Series tool belts.
